

# British Gymnastics Teacher' Intermediate Gymnastics Award (Primary)



This course qualifies learners support the delivery of primary school gymnastics as part of curricular and extra-curricular lessons. Learners build confidence, develop skills to support and teach set moves as well as discovering how to support participants in floor skills, as well as acrobatics and rhythmic elements. They also focus on fault identification and correction, how to incorporate apparatus and sequencing into lessons and how to understand and underpin good body movement in primary gymnastics.
